For \$320.00 (non-Hope enrolled families will also have a \$50.00 registration fee) per student, you will have access to every subject listed. This is a per student license and you will be set up as a teacher in the program. Licenses run August 10th to August 1st of each year. There is no proration for licenses.

The program offers placement testing, credit recovery, sets up your lesson plan, assigns lessons automatically, and is flexible enough to change at anytime (sickness, vacation, life event, etc). It also keeps up with your grades and tallies the percentages for you. There are a some narrative type questions you must grade, as well as projects & experiments, but all multiple choice questions are graded by the system.

You will also have the freedom to activate, hold, and archive subjects as needed. You will also be able to reschedule missed days, as well as hold coursework for vacation days and holidays.

Aimee has also done an incredible job of putting together a "how to" and "tips & tricks" manual. This will be sent to you at registration.

Hope Online is your curriculum provider only. Fees are based on registration as a Hope Student or as a non-Hope Student. • WHAT IS HOPE ONLINE?

- O Hope Online is a versatile and multi-functional online learning platform, with streamlined efficiencies and interactive features that enrich the educational experience for Christian teachers and students in elementary, middle, and high school. Hope Online offers curriculum for grades 3-12 covering all the core subjects and a multitude of electives. Due to this wide offering, you are able to pick and choose what will work best for your unique student. If a class does not fit, you can drop it and enroll them in another class.
- This program is designed for use in Christian schools and as such, it has some unique aspects. First, it uses school wide calendar, so it will use the calendar setup by Hope for the assigned school days, however, you can put assignments on hold to fit your school year.
- Since it is setup for classroom use, we must assign your students to you. To do this, we must enroll your student in an initial course. We have created a very basic one-page introduction to Hope Online as the course. This simply serves as a tool to assign your student to you as their teacher and does not constitute an actual class or credit towards any work. It will conclude with one question that they answer, and the course is complete.

Placement Tests

If you are unsure where to begin, Hope Online offers a Placement Test option. This will help ensure that your student starts off on the level best suited for them. We have included a copy of the Placement Test Guide to assist you in the process. Perhaps, you know what grade, but are worried about gaps, you may want to consider the Prescriptive Credit Recovery Mode.

CRx (Prescriptive Credit Recovery) Mode:

CRx (Prescriptive Credit Recovery) Mode is designed to allow students who have previously taken a course to revisit the course and receive credit for material they have already mastered without having to repeat the entire course. Currently, the threshold defaults to 70. We do recommend that if you use this feature, you consider a higher threshold. After all, you want to be certain that it starts them at a level where they have mastery of what is considered recovered. Best of all, it's simple for teachers to implement. Just choose the course in the Add Enrollment window. Check the CRx Mode box and click the Add Enrollment button. We have included two resources to assist you. You will find the CRx User Guide and the CRx Pacing Guide.

For those of you using Hope Online for a High School Student, there are a multitude of Electives available for you.
